Peace and security

The horn of Africa being one of the most destabilised regions in the world, peace and security is our main concern. The reasons for instability and insecurity in the region are :

Organize civil society parliaments parallel to government structures and regional bodies such as IGAD AND East African Parliament.

As heavy debts have devastating effects on the society, Alliance and International citizens should advocate for cancellation of debts.

Create a system that would not regenerate the debt burden.

Strive to satisfy the basic human needs before everything as first priority.

Enhance utilization of local resources and appropriate technology.

Prioritise solution oriented education, sound policies and an enabling environment to realize sustainable development.

Globalization

It is important for the Alliance to formulate and work towards an equitable world economic order.

We need to play an active role that the New World trade order should be levelled.

Promote fair not free trade.

Globalization should be tamed to respond to local needs.

Reform of International Institutions (IMF, World Bank, WTO)

Bring to a halt development concept being used as tool of recolonization of Africa.

Modern technological infrastructure should be adapted and put in place.

People should rule the market and not the vice versa.
